7. ZONE REPRESENTATIVE REPORTS

7.1. Zone 1 - Jilinda Lee

Focus will be on increasing membership in Zone1. Goal is to have at least 1 member from each Council. Has attempted to meet with Abigail for handover, however, has not been able to speak with Abigail as yet.

Sent out a newsletter to all Zone 1 members initially as Vital newsletter. Also sent out an ALGWA newsletter in February including Mayors, CEOs and database members. Has created a Zone 1 database.

Planning to visit Indigenous councils in March also to promote the WLA event. Another idea is to get an ALGWA ambassador in each Council. As an incentive perhaps the ambassador would get free membership.

Discussed the need for ALGWA to have a media platform which Zone representatives could use to send out newsletters etc.

Visited Cairns Regional Council which emphasised the need for ALGWA to have a clear message of why we exists and benefits of becoming a member. Gathering contact details for executive staff in councils is difficult and an area that needs some consideration.

7.2. Zone 2 - Cr Jan Clifford

Met with Mackay Regional Council who have indicated that they have suitable facilities and would be willing to host a workshop/event for ALGWA. Jilinda advised that WLA would also be holding an event in Mackay with an opportunity to also partner with them as has been done in Cairns and Townsville. Will also follow up with one of her directors in relation to joining ALGWA.

Pierina advised that she was able to secure a venue at no cost to ALGWA for any events/workshops in Townsville.

7.3. Zone 3 - Cr Jo McNally

Southern Downs Regional Council currently has 2 out of 3 directors who are female. Will be sending out a Zone newsletter once AICD workshop details are finalised. 135 people will be attending the International Women's Day event in Warwick.

7.4. Zone 4 - Cr Daphne McDonald

Will be sending out a Zone newsletter once AICD workshop details are finalised and has assistance from Council to create newsletters and send to members.

10. DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT, RACING AND MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS AND AICD COURSES

Cr Judy Peters and Cr Anne Glasheen met with representatives from the Department of Local Government, Racing and Multicultural Affairs (Department) on Thursday, 28 February 2019. The Department advised it is willing to work together to deliver outcomes for local government. Events do not have to be held in Brisbane and the Department requested that ALGWA present ideas for future workshops.

The Australian Institute of Company Directors (AICD) Governance Essentials for Local Government Program has approximately 25 places available and the Foundation for Directorship Program has 12 places available. The Department has asked ALGWA to engage with rural, remote and indigenous councils and encourage them to apply.

It was agreed that the close of applications would be the end of April 2019. If applications are received from Councils that are not considered rural, remote or indigenous, ALGWA is able to put forward reasons for that person to be nominated for the courses. Discussion took place about ALGWA providing support for applications from members who are not affiliated with a Council.

ACTION:

- 1. Karen Murray to develop an application form to be used by members to apply for the AICD courses.
- 2. Karen Murray to investigate which council areas are considered rural, remote or indigenous by the Australian Taxation Office.

11. WORKSHOP OPTIONS

Pierina Dalle Cort advised she had spoken with Kim Skubris who is happy to work with ALGWA to deliver a workshop on media/social media including building your personal and career brand. Discussion took place on considering holding this workshop with our AGM or another event. It was agreed that the workshop be free for ALGWA members and non-members pay a registration fee to be determined once finalised.

It was agreed that the social media/marketing be the first workshop held in late July or August in Brisbane and combined with the AGM and a networking event.

ACTION:

Pierina Dalle Cort to investigate with Kim Skubris if she is interested in or able to also provide a webinar for this course.

Meeting with Local Government Managers Association (LGMA)

Judy Peters, Anne Glasheen and Karen Murray met with the Chief Executive Officer, Peta Irvine, of the LGMA on Friday, 28 February 2019. Peta advised that the LGMA will be delivering a Women in Local Government Leadership Forum on 7-8 November in Brisbane and would be happy to partner with ALGWA for this event.

One of the focuses for the forum is looking at understanding council budgets and policies. It was agreed that ALGWA partner with LGMA and deliver a financial sustainability workshop at this forum.



Resilience and Wellbeing Workshop

Discussion took place on the other workshop topics previously discussed. It was agreed that the resilience and wellbeing workshop be combined with the conflict resolution workshop making this a full day workshop for members.

ACTION:

All members to consider possible presenters for the financial sustainability, health and wellbeing and conflict resolution workshops.

12. 50/50 DIVERSITY PROJECT

The ABC is seeking women to nominate to be on a contact list to become a potential contributor to the ABC News digital and broadcast platforms. This is an opportunity for women to contribute to the national conversation. Interested women are required to complete the nomination form. Management Committee members agreed this was a wonderful opportunity and were encouraged to nominate themselves.

- Nikki Te Wano to include this information in the next newsletter to members and also include the information on the website.
